TENDER FOR THE CLEANING AND HAULING OF GARBAGE AND CONCH SHELLS FROM THE POTTER'S CAY DOCK AND THE DAILY CLEANING OF THE AREA SURROUNDING THE DUMPSTERS

1. PROPERTY TO BE MAINTAINED: THE POTTER'S CAY

2. PROJECT SCOPE - THE CLEANING AND HAULING OF GARBAGE AND CONCH SHELLS FROM POTTER'S CAY DOCK.

- Placement of three (3) 20 yard dumpsters for the collection of conch shells and garbage which are accumulated from the Fruit, Vegetable & Fish Market Vendors.
- Hauling and dumping of conch shells on a daily basis or as the need arises.
- A daily cleaning of the area surrounding the collection dumpsters.
- Pressure cleaning of the aforementioned area once per month, which would assist in suppressing any odor.
- Provision of labourers for the cleaning of the area surrounding each dumpster during the hours of 6am to 6pm daily, inclusive of weekends and holidays.
