9n commemoration of the 41^{st} Anniversary since its establishment in 1973, the Government Printing Department is planning an Open House and Exhibition for Friday, 28^{th} March, 2014. Invitations to attend and participate in the exciting one-day schedule of activities will be extended to representatives from all agencies of the Government that submit print jobs to GPD.

The following are among the activities and events being planned:

- the premiering of an historical documentary in which past and present staff talk about the development of the organization over the 40 years of its existence;
- 2. the publishing of a commemorative 40th Anniversary Booklet, in which funds raised from advertisements sold will help to defray the cost connected with hosting the event;
- a comprehensive tour of the plant for the purpose of providing participants with indepth information about the types, purpose, capacity and level of sophistication of the equipment presently at the plant;

- 4. a glimpse into the short and intermediate plans for manpower development and facility and equipment upgrade at the plant;
- exhibitions by the Royal Bahamas Police Force and the Royal Bahamas Defence Force on health and safety initiatives implemented at GPD;
- 6. exhibition by Heidelberg, USA;
- exhibition by architects from the Ministry of Works and Urban Development on the proposed renovation and reconfiguration and conversion of the former Holiday Ice Building to the GPD warehouse;
- exhibition by architects from the Ministry of Works and Urban Development on the proposed creation of a new Dark Room at GPD; and
- 9. exhibitions by Ministries/Departments that are considered to be high volume users of the services offered by GPD.

All things being equal, 28th March promises to be a memorable day for GPD.

DIRECTIONS:

Heat oil in a large, heavy pot (use a Dutch oven) over medium heat. Add bacon and cook until brown and crisp, stirring frequently. Use a slotted spoon to transfer bacon to a plate. Add onion and cabbage to pot and cook, stirring often, until cabbage is wilted (about 10 minutes). Add vinegar, sugar, and soy sauce and cook until cabbage is crisp-tender, about 10 more minutes. Stir in bacon.


