Online Master in Ibero-American International Relations for the 2013/2014 academic year at the King Juan Carlos University of Spain

Eligibility –

All applicants are required to possess a Bachelors Degree and a good command of the Spanish Language. This may be accredited either through:

- (a) DELE Diploma in Spanish as a Foreign Language, B2 level or its equivalent.
- (b) Passing a test of spoken and Written Spanish administered by the University.

The University leaves the right to carry out preliminary verification of adequate education level of the corresponding foreign degree and confirm that it provides with the right to access to post graduate degrees.

07th May, 2013 to 28th June, 2013

Extraordinary period, if any places are left unfilled:

05th to 13th September, 2013.
