It also will assess progress toward reducing COVID-19 mortality, morbidity, and economic impact.

. During the mid-term evaluation, the consultant will:

- Provide a complete and systematic analysis, including quantitative and qualitative measures of the criteria of relevance, effectiveness, efficiency, sustainability, and possible impacts of the Program;
- Review the progress of the activities planned for the period under analysis, any potential deviations from the execution plans, and their causes Define configuration specifications and business analysis requirements;
- Provide corrective measures and identify the products generated up to that point, the materialization of risk identified in the Risk Matrix, and the application of corresponding mitigation measures;
- Assess the progress towards the established product and results indicators, as well as the achievement of
 the plans set forth in the AOP and will also formulate recommendations on corrective actions and identify
 good practices;
