The Ministry of Health advises that Update \#441 of the COVID-19 Report indicated that there were 113,487 RT-PCR tests completed on $10^{\text {th }}$ June, 2021. The general public is informed that this number was a miscalculation and should have been written as 101,358 RT-PCR tests completed. Consequently, an amendment was made to the total number of RT-PCR tests completed on $10^{\text {th }}$ June, 2021, and the results of this amendment is reflected in today's COVID-19 Report.
