KNOW YOUR RIGHTS UNDER THE DPA

Individuals have rights under the Data Protection (Privacy of Personal Information) Act, 2003, (DPA) which give them greater control over the way their personal information is handled.

As an individual, the DPA allows you to:-

- know why personal information is being collected and how it will be used.
- ask for access to your records (including your health information).
- stop receiving unwanted direct marketing material.
- correct inaccurate information about you.
- ensure your information is only used for purposes you have been told about.

Indeed, section 8 of the DPA mandates that any individual making a written request to a Data Controller has a right, within 40 days to:-

- Be informed by the Data Controller if the data kept on him include personal data relating to him.
- Be supplied with a copy of the information on him.

Be entitled to an explanation to such information, if appropriate.
