ANIMAL PROTECTION AND CONTROL ACT, 2010 (No. 19 of 2010)

ANIMAL PROTECTION AND CONTROL (DOG LICENCE AND IDENTIFICATION TAG FEES) REGULATIONS, 2023

The Minister in exercise of the powers conferred by section 36(l) of the Animal Protection and Control Act, 2010 (No. 19 of 2010) hereby makes the following regulations —

1. Citation and commencement.

- (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Animal Protection and Control (Dog Licence and Identification Tag Fees) Regulations, 2023.
- (2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1st July, 2023.

2. Interpretation.

In these Regulations —

"intact" means a dog that has not been spayed or neutered;

"neutered" means a dog whose testes have been removed by way of surgical procedure;

"spayed" means a dog whose female reproductive organs have been removed by way of surgical procedure.

3. Certificate evidence spayed or neutered.

Any person applying for a licence and identification tag for a spayed or neutered dog shall produce a certificate from a licensed veterinarian showing that the dog has been spayed or neutered.

4. Fees.

- (1) The fees specified in the second column of the *Schedule* shall be in respect of that licence specified in the first column of the *Schedule*.
- (2) Any fee or charge collected under these Regulations shall be paid into the Consolidated Fund.

(b)	spayed or neutered dog	Nil
