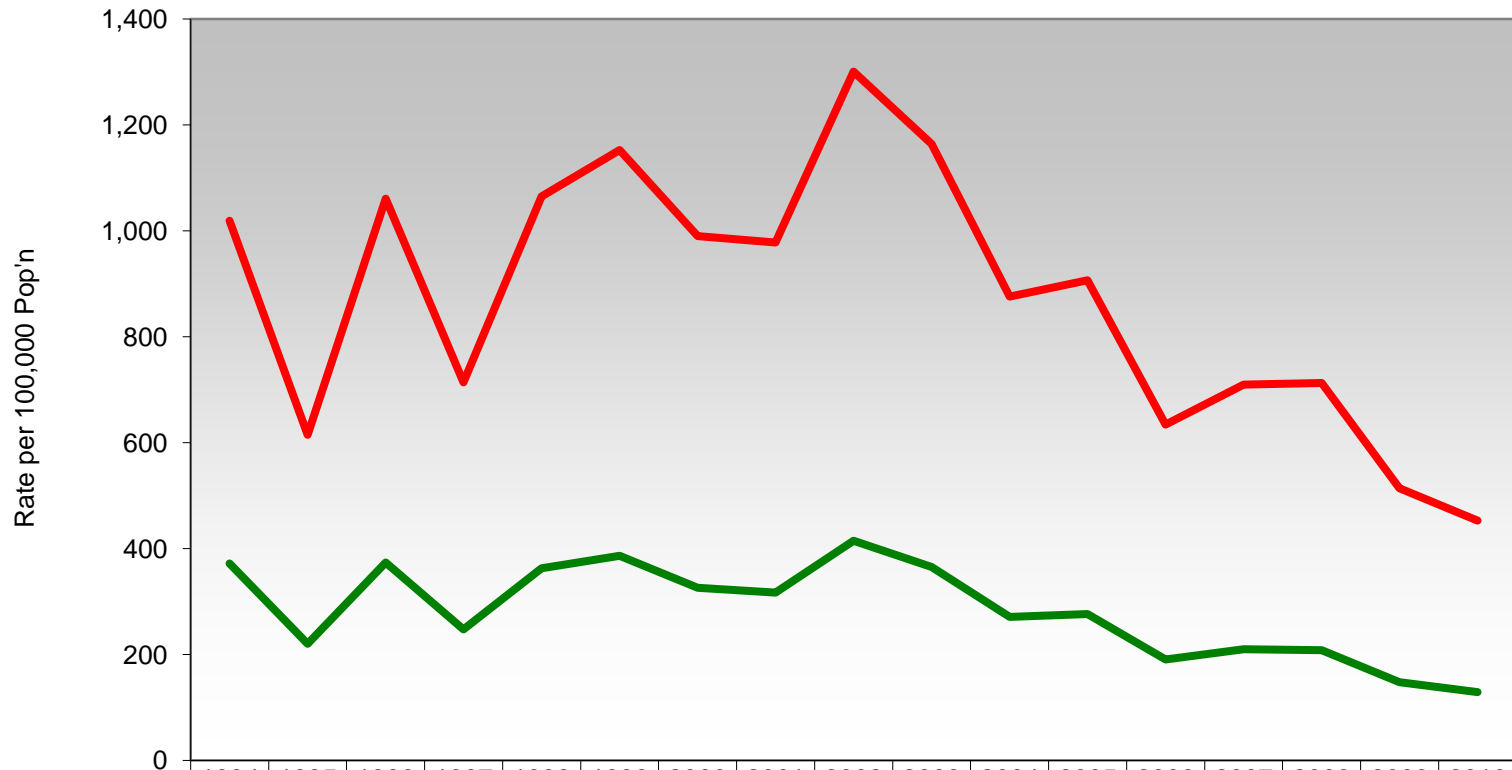
* Prior to 1994, it was not clear as to whether streptococcal infection meant a sore throat or scarlet fever; it is listed here as sore throat.

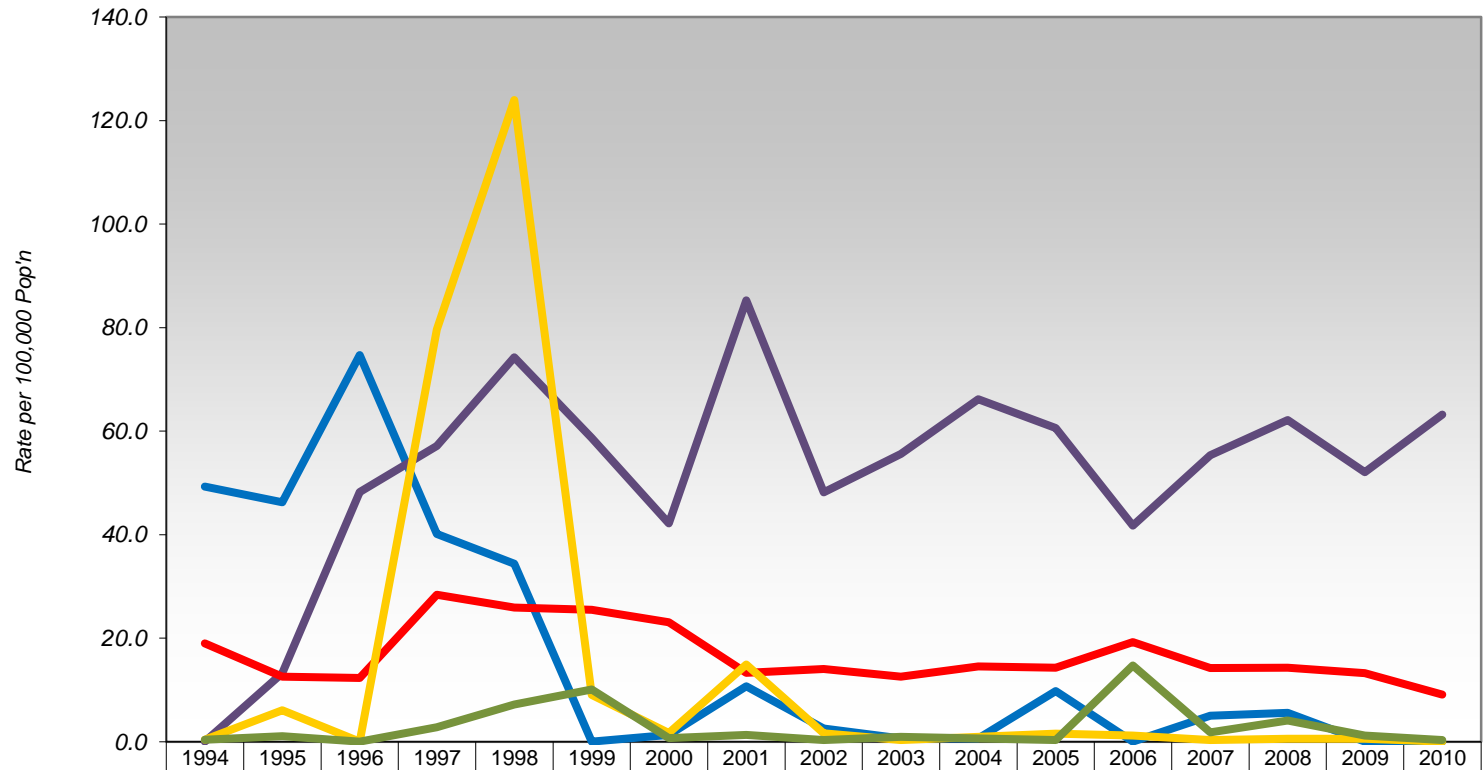
