FOREWORD

This publication represents data on the work permits granted in The Bahamas by the Department of Immigration for the year 2019. It contains tables outlining work permits granted by industry, occupational group, the applicants' nationality and sex.

The data in this report are collected by the Department of Immigration and forwarded to the Department of Statistics where they are processed, analyzed and published.

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DATA HIGHLIGHTS

• In 2019 a total of **12,501** work permits were issued. Males received **67% or 8,431** work permits whereas females received **4,070**, or 33% of the work permits.

Occupational Level:

- Sixty-three percent (63%) of the work permits were granted to workers in the Elementary Occupational group. Sixty-nine percent (69%) of the work permits granted to persons in this group were Haitians.
- **Professionals, Science and Engineering Professionals** Workers were granted **1,028 or eight percent (8%)** of the total permits issued. **Fifteen percent (15%)** of this group were Americans.
- This was followed by Managers, Chief Executives and Senior Officials with 924 or seven percent (7%) of the total work permits. Twenty nine percent (29%) of this group were Americans and thirteen percent (13%) British.
- The least amount of work permits granted (12 or 0.1%) was in the Skilled Agricultural, Forestry and Fishery Workers.

Industry Level:

- The industry receiving the majority of the work permits in 2019 was the Activities of Households as Employers; Undifferentiated Goods and Services-Producing Activities of Households for Own Use with 6,751 or 54% of the work permits granted. Forty five percent (45%) of this group were males.
- This was followed by the **Construction** Industry receiving **1,283 or 10%** of the total permits issued. **Ninety-five percent (95%)** of this group were **males**.
- Accommodation and Food Service Activities was issued **1,250 or 10%** of the total work permits for 2019. **Seventy-nine percent (79%)** of this group were **males.**

Nationalities

- The majority of the work permits 5,602 or 45% were issued to Haitians.
- This was followed by **Jamaicans** with 1,465 or 12% of the permits issued.
- **Philippine** nationals received 1,413 or 11% of the permits issued.
