## **VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS FOR PERSONS ENTERING THE BAHAMAS**

## **Yellow Fever**

Country requirement: a yellow fever vaccination certificate is required from travellers over 1 year of age arriving from countries with risk of yellow fever transmission and for travelers having transited more than 12 hours through the airport of a country with risk of yellow fever transmission. The following countries are listed below.

Africa: Angola, Benin, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cameroon, Central African Republic, Chad, Congo, Côte d'Ivoire, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Equatorial Guinea, Ethiopia, Gabon, Gambia, Ghana, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Kenya, Liberia, Mali, Mauritania, Niger, Nigeria, Rwanda, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Sao Tome and Principe, South Sudan, Somalia, Sudan, Togo, Uganda and United Republic of Tanzania.

**South America**: Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Colombia, Ecuador, French Guiana, Panama, Paraguay, Peru and Venezuela.

## Malaria

Malaria: Sporadic local transmission of P. falciparum has been reported in recent years on Great Exuma island only, subsequent to international importation of parasites. No risk on other islands. Recommended prevention on Great Exuma island: Mosquito bite prevention only Rabies Low risk Pre-exposure immunization recommended for people likely to have contact with bats.
