FISHERIES ACT, 2020 (No. 40 of 2020)

FISHERIES RESOURCES (JURISDICTION AND CONSERVATION)(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2023

The Minister in exercise of the powers conferred by section 126(2)(n)of Fisheries Act (No. 40 of 2020) hereby makes the following regulations —

1. Citation and commencement.

- (1) These Regulations, which amends the Fisheries Resources (Jurisdiction and Conservation) Regulations¹, may be cited as the Fisheries Resources (Jurisdiction and Conservation)(Amendment) Regulations, 2023.
- (2) These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July, 2023.

2. Repeal and replacement of Second Schedule to the principal Regulations.

The Second Schedule to the principal Regulations is repealed and replaced as follows —
