****IMPORTANT NOTES****

The Ministry of Health advises that due to continuous data cleansing of the COVID-19 database and collaboration with reporting laboratories, eighty-six (86) additional confirmed COVID-19 cases were added to the total number of cases - thirty-two (32) cases in New Providence and fifty-four (54) cases in Grand Bahama. These cases have now been added to today's COVID-19 report.
