Applications are invited from suitably qualified Bahamians to fill the position of INTERNAL AUDITOR IV in the Internal Audit Unit (New Providence), Ministry of Finance.

Minimum Qualifications Required:

Applicants must possess

- Associate's Degree in Accounting (from an institution accredited for Government's purposes), with minimum of five (5) years' relevant experience
- Bachelor's Degree in Accounting (from an institution accredited for Government's purposes), with a minimum of two (2) years' relevant experience
- Preference will be given to persons with the Bachelor's Degree in Accounting, but consideration will be given to persons with Associate's Degree in Accounting with strong prospects
- Salary will be in the range of \$32,550 to 40,850 per annum and commensurate with qualifications and experience

Job Summary:

Carry out internal audits on the accounting system operated by the Treasury Department and those Ministries and Departments supporting Treasury Department's system.

Specific Duties and Responsibilities of the post include:

Under the general guidance provided by Director of Internal Audit/Chief Audit Executive:

- i. Plan the theory and scope of the audit assignment and execute the audit plan in accordance with supervision from senior auditors.
- ii. Conduct internal audits on the financial accounting system and procedures of the Treasury Department.
- iii. Conduct the internal audit on the financial accounting system and procedures of the various Ministries and Departments which support the Treasury Department's financial accounting system.
- iv. Assess the internal accounting controls for the areas under audit.
- v. Determine the compliance with established laws, policies and procedures for the areas under audit.
- vi. Make oral presentations to managers during and at the conclusion of the audit, discussing deficiencies and recommending corrective action.
- vii. Prepare formal written reports, express opinions on the adequacy and effectiveness of the system and evaluate the efficiency with which activities are carried out.
- viii. Provide recommendations for correcting unsatisfactory conditions.
- ix. Perform any other duties assigned.

Successful candidates will be appointed on contractual terms of two (2) years (with gratuity payable upon satisfactory completion of the contractual period).
