This publication represents data on the work permits granted in The Bahamas by the Department of Immigration for the year 2021. It contains tables outlining work permits granted by industry, occupational group, the applicants' nationality and sex.

The data in this report are collected by the Department of Immigration and forwarded to the Bahamas National Statistical Institute where they are processed, analyzed and published.

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DATA HIGHLIGHTS

In 2021, the country was rebounding from the effects of the Pandemic. Work permits were
granted on a case by case basis, hence, total number of permits issued during this year is
significantly lower compared to previous years. In 2021 a total of 859 work permits were issued.
Males accounted for 69% or 593 work permits whereas females accounted for 266, or 31% of
the work permits granted.

Industry Level:

- The industry receiving the majority of the work permits in 2021 was the Activities of Households as Employers; Undifferentiated Goods and Services-Producing Activities of Households for Own Use with 327 or 38% of the work permits granted. See Table 1.
- This was followed by the **Construction and Education Industries** with both industries receiving 126 or 15% of the total permits issued. Education comprised of 73 males and 53 Females. Construction comprised 121 males and 5 Females. **See Table 1.**

Occupational Level:

- Forty-three percent (43%) of the work permits were granted to workers in the **Elementary Occupational group**. **See Table 2**. Thirty-three percent (33%) of the work permits granted to persons in this group were Haitians. See **Table 3**.
- Professionals, Science and Engineering Professionals were granted 159 or nineteen percent (19%) of the total permits issued. See Table 2. Nineteen percent (19%) of this group were Americans. See Table 3.
- This was followed by Managers, Chief Executives and Senior Officials with 114 or thirteen percent (13%) of the total work permits. See Table 2. Thirty-four percent (34%) of this group were Haitians. See Table 3.
- The least amount of work permits granted (6 or 0.7%) were to the category of **Clerical Support Workers. See Table 2**.

Nationalities

- The majority of the work permits 260 or 30% were issued to **Haitian nationals.**
- This was followed by **Filipinos** with 105 or 12% of the permits issued.
- Americans received 79 or 9% of the permits issued. See Table 4
