- Press 1 if you have been tested positive for COVID-19 or been in contact with someone who tested positive or have not heard from the Surveillance team
- Press 2 if you are a business calling about a workplace exposure or protocols
- Press 3 if you are calling about electronic quarantine monitoring (Hubbcat), please press 3
- Press 4 if you are calling about domestic or international travel
- Press 5 if you are calling to report a violation to the public health measures or Emergency Orders
- Press 6 if you believe you are having COVID-19 symptoms or any other general COVID-19 queries
- Press 0 to repeat the menu options
