CONSUMER PRICE INDEX – OCTOBER 2022


PRESS RELEASE

The Bahamas National Statistical Institute is pleased to announce the release of its Consumer Price index, October 2022.

The Monthly Inflation Rate in the Bahamas, which represents the overall change in prices, for October 2022 increased by 0.3% when compared to September 2022. This increase is reflected in the overall price of items purchased by the average consumer during this period. This October 2022 increase followed a similar increase of 0.3% between the months of August and September 2022.

The majority of categories saw some type of increase for the month, when compared to the previous month. The major increases were reflected in the categories of Food and Non-Alcoholic beverages showing a 4% increase, and Recreation and Culture with a 3% increase. Meanwhile, Transport along with Clothing were the two groups that saw a decline of 2% and 0.1% respectively.

On a year over year basis the CPI rose 7% over the same period in 2021. All Major Categories saw increases for the month when compared to the same period in 2021. The major categories that contributed to this rise included, the Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages category which saw an 18% increase, Recreation and Culture rose 17% while Restaurants and Hotels saw a 13% rise.



Meanwhile, diesel prices were up 36% compared to this same time period in 2021 and gasoline rose by 14%. However, on a monthly basis gasoline prices dropped 5%, while diesel prices also declined but at a slower pace of 2% for the month of October 2022.
