E. CLEMENT BETHEL ARTS FESTIVAL DANCE RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Competitors are required to be in the hall <u>at least 15 minutes before</u> the Dance segment of the Festival begins. The Committee reserves the right to disqualify any entrant who is not ready when called.
- 2. No one person may belong to more than one group **in the same class**.
- 3. The performance of a piece shall begin only at the signal from the adjudicator.
- 4. All dances must be titled. Not necessarily the title of the music.
- 5. Adjudication criteria:
 - a. TECHNIQUE- 50%
 - b. CHOREOGRAHPY- 25%
 - i. Design
 - c. PRESENTATION & STAGING- 20%
 - i. Use of Music
 - d. COSTUME-5%

TECHNIQUE

Competitors will be adjudicated on there execution of the dance genera entered. Choreography should be at the level of skill the Competitors are currently working at in regular classes. This also refers to the use of their bodies.

CHOREOGRAHPY

Attention will be paid to the form of dance, e.g.; Classical Ballet, the content of the movement and the concept of Dance elements. Originality is encouraged. **Design -**This refers to the patterns that are used by the choreographer. Please avoid everything in one line (FLAT).

PRESENTATION & STAGING

Competitors will be adjudicated on there use of stage, space and the presentation of the choreography. Present what has been choreographed.

Selection and Use of Music-Music and choreography should relate to the Dance and Dance form. Music with interesting variations is recommended. Please ensure that the Choreographer use the music to its full potential, e.g.; listen to your music more than once before starting your choreography.

COSTUMES

Should be suitable to the dance form that the competitor is participating in, this includes dance shoes, e.g.; Jazz performance requires Jazz shoes. Costumes must be neat.

- 6. Those persons not wishing to compete in the Festival may enter for Adjudication only.
- 7. Participants for the Final Concert(s) will be chosen on recommendation of the adjudicator.
- **8.** There is a special Festival Award for the Most Outstanding Individual, Most Improved Group and Hubert Farrington Choreography Award.
 - Most Outstanding Individual- Solo performances only, students or individuals who have shown improvement or have an outstanding performance during the adjudication process.
 - **Most Improved Group-** groups, schools or community organizations that have improved or presented an outstanding dance presentation.
 - **Hubert Farrington Choreography Award-** This award is presented to the individual choreographer who has presented outstanding choreography, which has shown improvements, or a good understanding of choreography and dance. **Choreographers wishing to qualify for this award must enter a minimum of three (3) pieces of choreography.**

These awards are all recommendations of the Adjudicator.

9. At the adjudication, no one is allowed to approach the adjudicator. ADJUICATORS DECISION IS FINAL.

DANCE GUIDELINES:

Category I CLASSICAL BALLET

Ballet is a precise technical dance form. Turned out legs, Precise movements, turns and pointed feet are required. PLEASE WEAR THE PROPER SHOES.

Category II BAHAMIAN FOLK

- a. Dance based on some aspect of Bahamian folk life e.g.; CRAB CATCHING, CONCHING, STRAW PLAITING, REGATTA, WORK DANCES, BAHAMAIAN MYTHS etc.
- b. SET DANCES: RING PLAYS, QUADRILLE AND HEEL &TOE POLKA.

Authentic music recorded of live must be used. Contact the Cultural Department for assistance. Music available for \$5.00.

Category III INTERNATIONAL FOLK

Dance must be based on the folk dances of other countries. Music, costuming and steps should be authentic to the Country chosen.

Category IV MODERN DANCE

Dance interpretation of any idea, theme or movement; Need not have a story line, can be abstract in nature e.g. Use of poetry or prose, theme of nature, emotion or colour.

Category V JAZZ DANCE

Jazz dance can take many different paths. It can also cross over into other styles of dance to be lyrical or contemporary. It can also be highly influenced by hip hop styles.

Some basic moves include: ball changes, twists pivot step, touch step, stag leap, jete`, pencil spin, , fan kick, jazz walk, jazz run, hip walk, chasses, cat walk and the catch step. PLEASE WEAR PROPER SHOES.

Category VI **POPULAR DANCES**

- a. Hip Hop
- b. Reggae

Dances should have relevant music to represent the style of dance. Please ensure that the music has no profanity.

Category VII DANCE DRAMA

- a. Interpretive
- b. Comtemporary
- c. Gospel

Dance can tell a story along with the song. Costumes and movement should be appropriate to the Dance.

Category VIII JUNKANOO CHOREOGRAPHED DANCE DIVISION

Participants are expected to Dance to live or recorded Junkanoo Music. They are required to be costumed in full Junkanoo Costume.

Category IX PERFORMANCE CATEGORY

This category was implemented for the choreographer to showcase a Performance/Ballet incorporating the students of all ages within the school. Performance MUST HAVE A THEME AND SYNOPSIS PRESENTED TO THE ADJUDICATOR FOR HIS/ HER VIEWING.
