FISHERIES (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2023

A BILL FOR AN ACT TO AMEND THE FISHERIES ACT

Enacted by the Parliament of The Bahamas

1. Short title and commencement.

- (1) This Act, which amends the Fisheries Act (No. 40 of 2020), may be cited as the Fisheries (Amendment) Act, 2023.
- (2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of July, 2023.

2. Amendment of section 31 of the principal Act.

Paragraph (b) of section 31(2) is repealed as replaced as follows —

- "(b) the transshipment, handling, buying, selling, receiving, possession, import or export of
 - (i) fish,
 - (ii) fish products,
 - (iii) fish included in a specified class, or
 - (iv) illegally caught fish.".

OBJECTS AND REASONS

Clause 1 of the Bill sets out the short title and commencement.

Clause 2 of the Bill seeks to replace the existing provision to expressly empower the Director to prohibit the transshipment, landing, buying, selling, receiving, possession, import or export of fish products.
