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FOREWORD

This publication represents data on the work permits granted in The Bahamas by the Department of Immigration for the year 2022. It contains tables outlining work permits granted by industry, occupational group, the applicants' nationality and sex. Prior to 2022, this report provided data for all work permits issued during the current year. However, **ALL** subsequent reports will provide data for work permits granted to 'New Applicants' during the current year.

The data in this report are collected by the Department of Immigration and forwarded to the Bahamas National Statistical Institute where they are processed, analyzed and published.

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DATA HIGHLIGHTS

• In 2022 a total of **18,028** work permits were issued to **'New Applicants'**. Males accounted for 81% or 14,563 work permits whereas females accounted for 3,465, or 19% of the work permits granted.

Industry Level:

- The industry receiving the majority of the work permits in 2022 was the **Activities of Households as Employers; Undifferentiated Goods and Services-Producing Activities of Households for Own Use** with 7,652 or 42% of the work permits granted. **See Table 1.**
- This was followed by the Transportation and Storage receiving 3,014 or 17% of the total permits issued. Accommodation and Food Service Activities followed with 2,145 or 12%. Transportation and Storage comprised of 2,828 males and 186 Females. Accommodation and Food Service Activities comprised 1,615 males and 530 Females. See Table 1.

Occupational Level:

- Forty-six percent (46%) of the work permits were granted to workers in the **Elementary Occupational group**. **See Table 2**. Ninety percent (90%) of the work permits granted to persons in this group were Haitians. See **Table 3**.
- **Technicians and Associate Professionals** were granted 3,190 or eighteen (18%) of the total permits issued. **See Table 2**. Thirty-nine (39%) of this group were Americans. **See Table 3**.
- This was followed by **Professionals, Science and Engineering Professionals** with 2,889 or sixteen percent (16%) of the total work permits. **See Table 2**. Forty-seven percent (47%) of this group were **Americans**. **See Table 3**.
- The least amount of work permits granted (30 or 0.2%) were to the category of **Clerical Support Workers. See Table 2**.

Nationalities

- The majority of the work permits 8,198 or 45% were issued to **Haitian nationals.**
- This was followed by **Americans** with 3,771 or 21% of the permits issued.
- Notably, Turkish, Mexicans and Filipinos received 2% of the permits issued. See Table 4
